



# Mater Health Services Brisbane

Located on the edge of the Brisbane CBD, Mater Health Services enjoys a unique position in the Queensland health care system, providing three public and four private collocated hospitals and a medical research institute. Mater's story began over 100 years ago when the Sisters of Mercy opened their first 20-bed private hospital in 1906.

Today, with more than 8000 staff and volunteers, Mater continues to provide exceptional care for over half-a-million people each year.



## Mater Adult Hospital

Mater Adult Hospital is a 205 bed facility hospital featuring a 24-hour emergency department, intensive and coronary care units, day surgery, day oncology, respite services, and medical, cancer and surgical units.

## Mater Children's Hospital

Mater Children's Hospital is a major tertiary referral centre providing an intensive care unit, theatres, inpatient and outpatient services and a 24-hour emergency department.

Subspecialty services include paediatric endocrinology, developmental paediatrics, respiratory/sleep medicine, paediatric medicine and surgery, paediatric cardiology, paediatric oncology, orthopaedic surgery, plastics and reconstructive surgery, craniofacial surgery, epilepsy/neurology, ENT surgery including cochlear implants and Child Youth Mental Health Services.

In May 2008 the Queensland Paediatric Cardiac Service (QPCS) relocated from the Prince Charles Hospital to Mater Children's Hospital. The QPCS has a dedicated state of the art Cardiac Theatre and Cath Lab, and a technologically advanced 14 bed cardiac ward which works closely with our expanding Paediatric Intensive Care/High Dependency Unit.

## Mater Mothers' Hospital

The new Mater Mothers' Hospital is the premier maternity facility in the southern hemisphere.

The Mothers' Hospital provides antenatal, perinatal and postnatal services, and specialises in caring for severe complications in pregnancy as well as newborn disorders. High-risk mothers and newborn babies are referred for specialist antenatal care through the centre for Maternal Foetal medicine, which is at the forefront in the development of innovative techniques for congenital and intrauterine malformations.

An expanded Neonatology Unit provides 71 cot spaces, including 25 Intensive Care cots, 12 High Dependency cots and 34 Special Care cots, making it the biggest neonatology unit in the southern hemisphere.
